

Only 302 Named On Day's Casualty List; Total for the Army Reaches 204,120

WASHINGTON, Dec. 29.—The War Department today gave out one casualty list which contained 302 names, bringing the total for the army up to 204,120. No Marine Corps casualty list was issued today, but the total previously reported for that arm of the service was 5,280. The total for the army and Marine Corps is now 209,400.

The army list issued today contained the names of 45 killed in action, 52 died of wounds, 10 died of accident and other causes, 46 died of disease, 112 severely wounded, and 57 missing in action.
